

# NARBOROUGH TROUT FARM

## RISK ASSESSMENT

*As we are a working fish farm there are inherent dangers of which we must be aware when inviting visitors onto the farm.*

*We do want your visit to be exiting and interesting so will try and make it safe without 'wrapping it in cotton wool'.*

**HAZARD: GRAVELLED CAR PARK, LEVEL BUT NEXT TO WATER.**

**RISK: Medium/High**

**CONTROLS:** *There must be careful monitoring by supervisors in this area*

*It is a public car park and other vehicles may be moving on it.*

*Children must not run as they might slip on the gravel.*

*When leaving the toilets they must not run out into the car park.*

*We are hoping to fence off a walking route to the toilet.*

**HAZARD: BRIDGE OVER THE STREAM TO START WALK.**

**RISK: High**

**CONTROLS:** *The Bridge has been newly renovated and has handrails but small children could lean through the rails and fall in so must be supervised at all times.*

*We will be putting additional wires across to make the gaps smaller.*

**HAZARD: BRIDGE OVER STREAM ONTO WALK**
